 - d) Membership Committee: Barry Flachsbart (Business & IST) and George Markowsky (Computer Science) have graciously volunteered to serve on the committee. According to the Rules & Regulations, we need at least one member from each of the following kinds of departments:
 - i. Engineering
 - ii. Science
 - iii. Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences
 - iv. Business Related

Since Computer Science is now part of Engineering, we may be able to consider George Markowsky as representing "an engineering department" as specified by the Rules & Regulations, and since Barry Flachsbart is from Business & IST, that would mean that we need someone from a Science Department and Someone from an Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences department.

- f) Proposal to accept the Pearson Test of English-Academic (PTE) scores as evidence of English language proficiency for Missouri S&T (see attachment)
