4. Informational Discussion on CEC Proposal to Create a Graduate Student Academic Year Performance Form to be Adopted for Campus-wide use
 - C. Potts gave introductory comments on the importance of the quality of the teaching mentorship and consideration of the conflicts of interests for the graduate students and the faculty.
 - F. Oboh-Ikuenobe has discussed the proposal on the necessity of creating Graduate Student Academic Year Performance Form for campus-wide use. There were some positive comments and several arguments against the necessity of such a form, including suggestions that there should be no special consideration of the graduate students depending on whether they are TA's or RA's; the roles of the advisory committee and the advisor; some departments, including chemistry, already have such procedure evaluating the graduate students; the advisor specific nature of the non-thesis students. It was proposed that there will be a small sub-committee to further formulate such a form.
